#### **Project outline**:

The project is concerned with the logical foundations of qualitative representation and reasoning applied in artificial intelligence. Qualitative Reasoning (QR) has emerged as a subfield of Artificial Intelligence to deal with representation and reasoning about continuous aspects of entities and systems in a symbolic, but human-like manner. The main issue in the QR approach is to develop an adequate tool for modeling situations in which information is not sufficiently precise or cannot be described by numerical values.

The project aims to develop logical theories and tools for qualitative representation and reasoning, with applications to many domains for which qualitative inference methods are significant. For more information contact the project leader.

## **Requirements**::

- The candidate should hold (or expect to obtain not later than 30 September 2013) the master degree preferably in philosophy, logic, mathematics, computer science, psychology or related field.
- A solid background knowledge on logic
- Strong motivation for scientific work
- Ability to work goal-oriented, both independently and as a part of the team
- Good command of written and spoken English

- Active participation in the research of the project
- Submitting research results for publication in international peer-reviewed journals
- Presenting results at international conferences and workshops
- Successful completion of a PhD thesis within 4 years
